EMAIL NEWS

Several text emails circulating this week supposedly from Nat West Bank regarding scheduled maintenance for online banking and you are required to click on a link and complete a form. The link takes you to a professional looking Nat West page on a server belonging to ldo3wwe.com.es in Israel in an attempt to gain your bank login details.

A previous hoax email is now re-circulating from Postcards.org. The heading is 'You have received a postcard from a family member' The message gives a link to click on, if you do so a virus will be downloaded onto your computer so please delete any of these messages, do not click on the link.

BOGUS CALLERS

In UPPER NORWOOD a white male, approx 30 years old, 5'09" tall wearing dark clothes called on an elderly male stating that he was fitting a washing machine in the next flat and asking if the occupier could turn off his water supply. The victim was unsure and the suspect entered the house and went into the kitchen, after several minutes the suspect came out and left. When the occupier went into his bedroom he found that cash was missing from his wallet.

From last Monday Post Office branches will be issuing the DWP Winter Fuel payments in cash to persons over the age of 60 years. These payments will be made until Monday 3rd December and will be made in cash. This opportunity of an increased haul may result in an increase in distraction burglaries. Please warn anyone who may be vulnerable of the danger of being followed home from the Post Office and to beware of bogus callers especially with the excuse of needing to check the water or the bogus Police who need to check your cash to check for stolen notes
